



LEMAN MULTIPLIES THE PHARMA WAREHOUSE CAPACITY

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The international freight forwarding and logistics company LEMAN is growing and expanding the warehousing facilities in Greve, which gives customers completely new opportunities.

Following a constructive dialogue with two of the company's customers, the warehouse has been expanded considerably, so that the capacity has multiplied. In addition to storage at +15-25 degrees, LEMAN can now offer to store active substances (API) on frost down to -20 degrees, while the storage area at + 2-8 degrees has been upgraded to a closed cold chain solution.

"For a number of years, we have invested heavily in the pharma segment, so I am pleased that we can now offer our customers even better solutions and grow with them," says Thomas Krøyer, Group CEO at LEMAN.
